Through Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) funding, Beacon awarded \$708,725 in emergency financial aid grants to undergraduate students experiencing unexpected expenses and unmet financial need as results of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Beacon also has currently expended \$811,547 in HEERF institution-related funding for COVID-19 impact related expenses such as lost revenue reimbursement due to pandemic, COVID-19 testing of community, PPE purchases & distance learning enhancements.
