This project will involve design, permitting, and construction to raise by two feet approximately 1,800 lineal feet of CR 42 near the intersection of CR 42 and Deerhaven Road. This portion of CR 42 crosses an isolated wetland and flood zone, which has been seen to stage up to a point where water has been on the road.

Due to topography, it is not feasible to drain this portion of the roadway/right of way elsewhere to alleviate the issue. CR 42 is a collector road and serves as the sole east/west maintained road for residents in the area. This project will aid in safety of a primary evacuation route for area residents.
