This project will reduce the threat to person and property that is caused by flooding events. When streets flood, it causes road closures, damage to vehicles and buildings, stormwater pollution, and hinders general accessibility for residents.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The general public is expected to be served by this project. Hundreds of pedestrians and vehicles traverse the area where flooding occurs in the central island area of the city. The project includes two stormwater pump stations that will resolve the problem and provide a direct benefit for all who travel through this area.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

This project will minimize flooding in the central island area of Sunny Isles Beach. This area is known to have major flooding during king tides, heavy rainfall, and storm surges. The success of the project will be assessed by measuring the amount of flooding, if any, post rain event. If flooding is present, the time it takes for flooding to recede will be examined.
