About 32,000 people living in the city will be served as the project scope includes citywide drainage outfalls and canal bank restoration/stabilization and related water quality improvements.

1. Public Safety improvement by stabilizing the canal banks
2. Surface Water Quality improvements by improving culverts/outfalls and canal bank stabilization/restoration
3. Elimination of the loss of property by stopping canal bank erosion
4. Improvements of the canal bank aesthetic beauty by enhancing canal bank stabilization with greenwise environment friendly technology
5. Drainage improvements by improving the culverts connecting canals.

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The maintenance of the drainage culverts and outfalls is an obligation to the city per the NPDES permit with the FDEP. The failure to maintain the system may be subject to violation of the permit and FDEP may impose penalties based on their regulations.
