12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Goal is to seek contractual engineering/design site work and construction services to build a 4,270 sq. ft. fire rescue facility on County owned property on Shell Point Road just south of US Highway 98 and to provide improved emergency fire, rescue services to protect lives and property. This facility's location will eliminate coastal flooding during natural disasters/storm events and sea level rise issues. Provides optimum coverage & response times. Improve/maintain ISO rating. Potential cost saving to citizens/residents and business community through improved insurance ratings.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Activities are securing engineering/design, site work and construction services through the County's procurement process to design and build a 4,270 sq. ft. fire station facility that will include two bays, kitchen, with fire fighter quarters.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Direct services to citizens is to provide efficient, reliable emergency services from a fire rescue facility that will provide optimum coverage, improve response times; provide safety services, protect lives and property; improved insurance ratings in this Rural Area of Opportunity.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The new fire rescue facility will serve Wakulla County residents, visitors and the business community in the Shell Point/US 98 areas. Greater than 37,000.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?



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Once constructed the new facility will provide for substantially improved fire rescue services with improved response times, optimum coverage and have the ability to offer additional emergency services in the event of a disaster. Benefit is protection of life, health, safety of citizenry, visitors, business community and property. Maintain/improve ISO rating, reduce insurance costs with nearby/local emergency fire rescue services in this Rural Area of Opportunity. Addresses the Public Safety Plan, Local Mitigation Strategy and the Adopted Infrastructure Plan.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Non-payment of invoices until milestones achieved; implementation of corrective action plan.
