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The Florida Housing Finance Corporation initially provided the City of Clearwater with \$634,546 in CARES Act funding for mortgage, rent, and housing assistance. The city expended the entire amount and requested an additional \$400,000 to fund remaining unfunded requests for assistance prior to the expenditure deadline. The city was able to expend \$279,814 of the additional funds within the restricted timeframe and returned \$120,186 to the state.

Funds will be used to raise the overall site. A large amount of the site fill is included in the design to lift most of the site by several feet to protect the site and various built infrastructure pieces.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The grade of the site will be raised with imported fill to lift new buildings out of the storm surge area.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The appropriation project will not provide a direct service to citizens. Once the redevelopment of the entire waterfront park is completed, the Imagine Clearwater project will provide residents and visitors with additional greenspace, a bluff walk, new restrooms and a dockmaster building, and an improved connection to the downtown.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The project will benefit no specific group. The enhanced waterfront park will be accessible to residents and visitors. More than 800 individuals are expected to be served.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Increased recreational and cultural programming opportunitites in addition to drawing greater economic and tourism activity to the downtown area.
