The goal will be to replace a wooden fishing pier/dock with an aluminum floating fishing pier/dock.

The target population of the City of Madison is approximately 3,000. On any given day 12 - 15 citizens utilize the fishing pier/dock as it permits them to cast out further in the lake.

The expected benefit will enhance a safe recreational outlet for both adults and children. This is the only desired fishing outlet in the City of Madison and is a main attraction to the lake.

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There are no penalties that the City of Madison will encounter. The absence of the fishing pier/dock simply eliminates an enjoyable recreational outlet to the citizens.
