THE MISSION OF THE FLORIDA SHERIFFS YOUTH RANCHES IS TO PREVENT DELINQUENCY AND DEVELOP LAWFUL, RESILIENT AND PRODUCTIVE CITIZENS. THE ULTIMATE GOAL IS UNIFICATION OF A HEALTHY NATURAL FAMILY.
