12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The specific purpose of this project is to replace the current pressure sewer system with a more economical gravity sewer system for residents on and around Bird Pond Road. By replacing the pressure sewer system with a gravity system, the existing grinder pumps can be removed from each house, thus reducing energy consumption and repeated maintenance of the grinder pumps. A gravity sewer system will benefit both parties and will bring a welcome solution to a problem that isn't feasible to be fixed by local funds. This will also be the final piece of converting all of the sewer forcemain in the City to gravity sewer, the rest of the areas will be funded using CDBG-DR Infrastructure funds.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

This funding will cover the permitting, design, inspection and construction of the sewer replacement.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The direct services of this project are a more economical and reliable sewer system. In the weeks following Hurricane Michael these pumps were a source of ground contamination and unsanitary conditions. With water service immediately available, but power service unavailable, the pump stations (which require electricity) at these residences would overflow and raw sewage would pour freely onto the ground within feet of the occupied residential structures.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population for this project are the citizens on Bird Pond Road which is approximately 30 citizens.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?



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By replacing the pressure sewer system with a gravity system, the existing grinder pumps can be removed from each house, thus reducing energy consumption and removing the burden of expensive repairs or replacements to be made by homeowners. Maintenance cost records and energy consumption records can be reviewed to determine the outcome of this project.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

It is not anticipated that failing to meet deliverables or performance measures will occur, however, if such penalties are needed, withholding funding would be an appropriate measure.

The City of Bristol owns, operates, and maintains the current low pressure sewer system and will maintain ownership of the gravity sewer system when constructed.
