Liberty County was allocated \$1,457,708 as part of the CARES Act for State and Local Governments. Funds were used for PPE, sanitizing supplies, labor, equipment and other items. Liberty County was allocated \$1,622,677 as part of the American Rescue Plan. Funds are to be used for Covid-19 mitigation efforts, replacement of lost public sector revenue, premium pay for essential workers, and investments in water.

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The specific goal of this project would be to improve aspects of the Courthouse for the use of the employees and the citizens of the County. Liberty County does not have the funds to be able to make these changes without financial assistance.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The ADA improvements will include a larger door and converting a set of stairs to a ramp. The "bandit barrier" glass will be installed for the protection of the employees. A sidewalk will be extended to a current parking area. The LED light fixtures will bring energy efficiency to the historic building. The focus of the landscaping will be the installation of matured oak trees to replace the landmark oak trees that were badly damaged/lost by Hurricane Michael among other improvements to bring beauty to the historic courthouse.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

All of these improvements will be for the betterment of the courthouse for the citizens of the County by providing safety, energy efficiency, and much needed landscaping to give the citizens pride in their County Courthouse.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

There is no specific target population. The individuals who will be served are the numerous citizens that come to the Courthouse for their local government business and the employees that work there every day.
