a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The Miami Gardens Higher Education Initiative (MGHEI) Scholarship Program is designed to provide financial assistance to high school graduates or Seniors who are in need of additional funding to actualize their dreams of attending and graduating from and institution of higher learning. The Scholarship Program will assist high school students by providing funding in the amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) to each eligible student.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The City of Miami Gardens will advertise the Miami Gardens Higher Education Initiative Scholarship Program through various publication mediums. Multiple methods will also be provided to residents for application submittal.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Twenty-five (25) eligible residents, who are high school students or graduates, will receive a scholarship in the amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000).

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

High school students, University/College students.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?



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Improve quality of education: How's students feel the scholarship has impacted their overall ability to excel in higher learning. Survey scholarship recipients regarding the outcome measure. Increase improve economic activity: Amount of scholarship recipients who graduate with their 2 year or 4 year degree and gain professional employment within Miami Gardens. Conducting surveys to track student progress after their collegiate careers. Divert from Criminal/Juvenile Justice System.

If scholarships are not awarded to a minimum of 25 residents, remaining funding will be refunded to the appropriating agency.
