a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Sidewalks and other transportation improvements will be provided that focus on enhancing the visibility of students, safe crossings, and the elimination of sidewalk gaps.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

This will provide safer facilities and crossings for students of Limona Elementary School, a neighborhood school surrounded by a compact community. These facilities will provide safer transportation options for students of Limona Elementary School, Brandon High School, and nearby residents. Improvements include raised crosswalks, sidewalks, speed management, and other safety solutions.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The population to be served will include, but is not limited to, elderly, students, and all neighborhood residents in the vicinity of Limona Elementary. While it is difficult to determine the number that will be served, the target population is expected to be over 800 people.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Expected benefits/outcomes include improved physical health via increased pedestrian and bike usage; protecting the general public from harm by increased access to safe transportation facilities for all users; and improved transportation conditions by improved/increased transportation facilities. Methods to measure these outcomes include pedestrian and bike usage/access; access to multi-modal transportation facilities; reduction in sidewalk and other multi-modal facility gaps; and increased safe crossings.
