12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Jewish Senior Transportation will enable a minimum 600 frail older adults, including over 275 Holocaust survivors, to age in place by providing access to free transportation to medical appointments as well as social, cultural, educational, and health and well-being programs in order to improve and maintain their physical, mental, and emotional health and well-being.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

At least 600 frail seniors in south Palm Beach County will receive free transportation to medical appointments and/or social, cultural, and educational programs for seniors who have disabilities, limited mobility, are unable to safely operate a motor vehicle, or have no other means of transportation. This will enable them to remain active members of society.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Free senior transportation will be provided directly to senior citizens.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The program expects to serve at least 600 older adults including approximately 275 Holocaust survivors receiving services from the Holocaust Survivor Assistance program; 200 members of the Weisman Delray Community Senior Center; as well as 180 seniors who no longer drive and are enrolled in a volunteer driven ride program (Kibbitz and Ride).

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

80% of respondents will indicate that STJFS helped to improve their physical health by providing access to health and fitness programs, and/or medical appointments. 80% of respondents will indicate that STJFS helped to reduce isolation and improve mental health by providing access to social events, individual counseling, and/or support groups. 80% of respondents will indicate that STJFS enabled them to participate in cultural experiences (e.g. chorus, theater, concerts, arts classes, seminars, etc.) Client pre- and post surveys will be administered at the start and end of the fiscal year. Additionally, number of registrants and number of rides provided will be monitored.



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f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Penalties for not meeting the contracted deliverables may warrant decreased funding. Standard contract penalties are sufficient.
