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4. Project/Program Description

The City of Blountstown is seeking funding to support the construction of a new City Hall building in Blountstown, Florida. The existing City Hall building still suffers damages from Hurricane Michael, including a leaking roof and unstable structures. The existing site has a smaller parking lot and drive-through that can be difficult to navigate during high-traffic times. The new site will provide an improved parking lot and drive-through that will provide for easier access for both the residents and workers, as well as attempt to create a safer environment due to the location and turnouts to the main highway. The proposed City Hall building will offer a safe and welcoming site for residents and city workers and will be built to be compliant with the most current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements to accommodate all citizens. The new site will also provide an improved traffic flow with a parking lot and drive-through that are easily accessible.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The existing site is in a high-traffic area with difficult access to the drive-through window. The new building site will be designed with providing safe ingress and egress in mind for residents and employees by creating easier access for parking and drive-through. The new building will also provide a safer facility for the city employees as well as individuals that do business there. This will further allow the city to relocate from the existing facilities which are still suffering from damages due to Hurricane Michael.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The existing site is in a high-traffic area with difficult access to the parking lot and drive-through window. The new site will be designed with safe ingress and egress in mind. Furthermore, an updated council room for public meetings will be provided and will allow the city to have all of their primary administrative functions in one location.

The target population is the City of Blountstown.
