The specific goal to be achieved with the requested funds is to convert septic to sewer properties occupying approximately 51 acres in the southwest corner of Powerline Road and NW 18th Street in the City of Pompano Beach. This project will protect our groundwater quality and supply.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The construction of a centralized sewer system will meet the intended purpose of these funds.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Wastewater services will be directly provided to the properties within the project 51 acre area.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

This project will connect 70 industrial/commercial properties to a centralized sewer system on approximately 51 acres.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected benefit of this project will improve water quality and result in a reduction of nutrients in the surface and groundwater. This commercial and industrial area has been hindered by the lack of a central wastewater system. This construction should spur development/redevelopment.
