	This project will include the design and construction of a toewood structure along approximately 4,000 LF of Apalachicola River shoreline in the Estiffanulga Community. This section of river has seen substantial shoreline erosion in the last 15+ years, averaging 3-4 feet of erosion per year. Liberty County has tried to work with State agencies in the past to try and mitigate the erosion but has been unsuccessful in obtaining the necessary funds. The erosion has now gotten to the point that County infrastructure is being threatened (Chattahoochee Circle, Estiffanulga Water System, Estiffanulga Boat Ramp) and mitigation, along with State support, is necessary. The toewood structure is a proven construction method to withhold further erosion while also giving nature habitat to all species of the Apalachicola River in this region.

Liberty County was allocated \$1,622,677 as part of the American Rescue Plan. Funds are to be used for Covid-19 mitigation efforts, replacement of lost public sector revenue, premium pay for essential workers, and investments in water.

12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

This project will include the design and construction of a toewood structure along approximately 4,000 LF of Apalachicola River shoreline in the Estiffanulga Community. This section of river has seen substantial shoreline erosion in the last 15+ years, averaging 3-4 feet of erosion per year. The erosion has now gotten to the point that County infrastructure is being threatened (roadway, water system, boat ramp) and mitigation, along with State support, is necessary and required.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The project will need to be designed, permitted, constructed and inspected for this project.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

This project will mitigate the erosion of the riverbank, which is threatening the homeowners property, an asphalt county road (Chattahoochee Circle), a public water system, a public boat ramp, and causing unsafe river conditions due to the current status.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population is County citizens and the countless individuals that utilize the public boat ramp and even the Apalachicola River, possibly 10,000+ individuals.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

To mitigate and stop the continued erosion of the Apalachicola Riverbank in the Estiffanulga community and save property, public infrastructure, and natural habitat. A county-wide survey can be advertised and distributed at the boat ramp and to the nearby property owners to judge the effectiveness of the improvements once the construction is complete.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

It is not anticipated that failing to meet deliverables or performance measures will occur, however, if such penalties are needed, withholding funding would be an appropriate measure.
