The Oceanside Adaptive Fitness Center and Park project was developed through a partnership between the City of Miami Beach and the Sabrina Cohen Foundation, a 501©3 non-profit organization. The project will be a first of its kind, state-of-the-art recreation and wellness facility alongside a fully accessible beach. The facility will be available to individuals of all ages and abilities and will provide adaptive fitness and recreational programs that provide a better quality of life for individuals living with paralysis and various disabilities. The Center will be located on Collins Avenue S.R. A1A on Miami Beach.

12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The goal of these funds is to construct an Adaptive Fitness and Recreation Center, and Oceanside Adaptive Park and Beach that will provide adaptive fitness and recreational programs to provide a better quality of life for individuals living with paralysis and various disabilities.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Construction, including walkways, landscaping, irrigation, adaptive playground, adaptive exercise equipment, fencing, seating and planning, permitting and engineering of the project. Fully accessible gym and a full schedule of daily programs with staff specially trained for veterans and paralysis groups, seniors and families of special needs youth.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

This center will be the first of its kind, a state of the art recreation and wellness facility alongside a fully accessible beach. The center will combine physical fitness that advances human activity with daily activities that promote mental and spiritual wellness.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Individuals living with paralysis and other mobility challenges - from children to adults to seniors.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Improve physical and mental health of participants. Obesity rates for adults with disabilities are 57% higher than for adults without disabilities. For people with disabilities, recreation and exercise are critical for health and well-being but are often difficult to access. Outcomes will be measured by participant surveys.

Termination of contract and penalties.
