a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The roadway will be redesigned to improve access for residents and the traveling public and to increase safety by expanding the roadway to include two 11' lanes with 1' shoulders.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The funds will be used for the reconstruction of the existing roadway.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Improved access for residents and businesses throughout the northernmost east-west connecting road in Okaloosa County.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The proposed project is expected to have a benefit for north Okaloosa County. The current population of the most directly-impacted city is the City of Laurel Hill, with 551 people.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The proposed project is expected to have safety benefits for all vehicular traffic coming through Okaloosa County along the roadway. The road is commonly used as a haul route for the timber industry and serves agricultural functions located in north Okaloosa County
