a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Alleviate area flooding as well as washouts during moderate and severe weather events. This will enable emergency vehicles to access the area under all atmospheric conditions, and will enable residential and commercial traffic to travel to and through the area with more ease.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Redesign and construction of a better suited area drainage systems that become impassable in even moderate weather events. The existing concrete drainage structure is over 50 years old and has been deteriorating rapidly. This deteriorated drainage conveyance will be removed in its entirety and reconstructed with Concrete to allow proper flow without backing up or creating washouts.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

This drainage system will assist multiple citizens directly adjacent to this structure and further up gradient where additional systems funnel into this main outfall. This outfall drains large areas on both sides (east and west) of County Road 309 between Goergetown Fl and Welaka Fl.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

All residents and visitors of Southern Putnam County north of the Georgetown Fl and South of Welaka Fl.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Access to area under all weather conditions and reduction in flood events for area.
