12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

County is seeking to develop a safe environment for students to play and attend school. A newly renovated campus will provide the school the opportunity to be in a safe and healthy environment as opposed to its current outdated facility. The project would allow SAA to grow its student population and faculty to meet the needs of the community at large. Building a new outdoor play area will encourage fitness for our students, as well as, creating a dedicated community area.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Funds will be used to retrofit existing facility to accommodate the Sarasota School for Performing Arts, including electrical upgrades. Additionally funds will be used to build a playground for students.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The intended purpose of these funds is to educate students in grades K-8th grade in a safe and update facility while encouraging the Arts. As a public charter school, education and community is a priority. This project will provide educational services, summer camps, and the daily use of an environmentally sustainable playground and gardens, Performing Arts venue, and a digital arts facility.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

400 grade students served.
