Direct services to citizens would use a variety of treatment modalities, such as universal screenings, self-management, and treatment by a coordinated care team that uses shared language, both verbal and non-verbal. In addition to primary health care and dental care, services by the behavioral health team will include medication management, psychotherapy, behavioral therapy and group counseling.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The completely renovated facility will result in expanded patient access to integrated behavioral health services for over 2,000 Hernando County area residents of all ages.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will

be measured?

Improve clinical outcomes and reduce health disparities within the patient population by improving overall health status of the citizens served in the health center facility.

Example #1: Diabetic patients 18-75 will have an HbA1C level of 9% of less.

Example #2: Patients 18085 whose blood pressure at their most recent visit will be adequately controlled SBP <140 and DBP <90.
