a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The goal of the proposed transmission forcemain is to direct wastewater from the western and southern areas of the City to the City's wastewater treatment plant (WWTP). The ability to provide wastewater service to these areas will allow economic growth in Dade City, a financially disadvantaged community.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The City of Dade City will construct a new wastewater transmission forcemain. Services will include surveying, engineering, permitting, design, construction, & CEI.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The appropriated project will provide wastewater service to citizens.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The project is expected to serve an estimated population of 12,890 residents.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The benefit of the project is the economic growth in the western and southern portions of the City. Growth can be measured in equivalent residential units added in these portions of the City. A secondary benefit is the reduced need for septic systems to serve commercial and residential growth. The outcome can be measured by the reduced number of septic tank permits.
