### 12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Our goal is to build an inclusive community where the benefits of educating and employing individuals with autism are broadly understood, supported, and valued while bringing new life and opportunities to an important local historic site.

Adults with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) will be given the curriculum, services, and supports needed to complete intensive learning experiences to increase their ability to maintain competitive employment and live independently.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Direct instruction in Learn4Independence coursework, applied learning in job settings (volunteer, paid and unpaid internships, competitive employment, self-employment), direct instruction in independent living skills, and applied learning through the residential component of NextStep at Endeavor Academy

Summer programs for targeted groups within the ASD population (high school students, women)

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?



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Direct instruction in both a classroom and natural (applied) setting, job coaching, help with identifying and accessing natural supports at work and in the community

Assessment, targeted goals (employment, social, communication, independent living), maintenance/follow-up checks to measure long-term progress after completing the program

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

This program will primarily serve adults with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD). Programs will be available for high school students with ASD as well.

As we build this program, we expect to serve an increasing number of individuals each year. For the year of requested funding, we expect to serve between 50-100 individuals with ASD.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected benefit/outcome of this program is obtaining/maintaining employment and independent living (in community of choice, which could also include continuing to live with family or a roommate). Participants will be evaluated and the beginning and end of the program to show improvement in the employment and independent living skills taught. Participants will show mastery of the curriculum through completion of the learning modules, earning a certificate. Participants will also have individualized goals throughout their time in the program and those goals will be closely monitored for progress, with data collected daily. Follow-up/maintenance checks will be conducted after participants complete the program to measure the number who obtain/maintain employment.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

If deliverables or performance measures are not met the funding will be returned to the state.
