a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Renovation of the historic Cornelia Young Library as a landmark Veterans Museum and Education Center will provide educational and historical enrichment to Daytona Beach students, residents, and visitors. Thousands of visitors will be educated through learning tours conducted by museum guides about American military history as related through over 60 display cabinets featuring thousands of artifacts from the American Revolutionary War to present day.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The Veterans Museum provides programs to educate students and the general public about the importance of American veterans and the Armed Forces of the United States through collection, documentation, interpretation, and presentation of tangible artifacts, photos, and personal stories by local men and women who served our country. The museum is open five days per week and conducts monthly meetings with presentations on a variety of subjects by noted historians, military, and civic leaders.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The museum will be a registered visitor site for Daytona Beach and is expected to brings thousands of visitors to the area each year. In addition the museum will serve local fraternal military organizations, students, and the general public as an additional educational opportunity.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The population of Daytona Beach, surrounding counties, and the entire state of Florida will be served by this project. Thousands of local residents and students plus statewide visitors will be served.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will



be measured?

The historic Cornelia Young Library building will become an attractive and well visited Veterans Museum and Education Center. Visitors are provided with detailed comment sheets about their visit. Results are tallied and reviewed by staff. Viable suggestions are implemented. The museum is also expected to help increase tourism in the Daytona Beach area by providing an alernative venue to the public during inclement weather. Visitor statistics will be tabulated and available.
