12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Levy County's current Emergency Operations Center (EOC) and emergency/public safety communications equipment is more than 20 years old. The construction of a new and state-of-the-art EOC will contain separate space for media and state emergency management officials; will exceed a proposed 13,000 sq. ft. minimum; and will contain separate shower and sleeping quarters and state-of-the-art equipment. Installation of modern and state-of-the-art emergency and 911 communications system and equipment.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Levy County is constructing an enhanced EOC for day-to-day functions and planning and preparation for emergency activation during times of storm, disaster, or other event. Levy County is forward thinking, 20-30 yrs of growth, and planning for a more functional and spacious EOC that will provide better services to all citizens and municipalities within Levy County.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

During times of extreme weather emergencies, natural disaster, or public emergencies the improved facilities will provide the opportunity for faster and more up-to-date relating of information to citizens and municipalities in Levy County. EMS and the EOC are activated nearly 100% of the time during any type of natural weather event due to Levy being a coastal county.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

As a coastal county, during times of emergency 100% of citizens of Levy County will be impacted.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will



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be measured?

The new EOC and emergency communication systems will improve information dissemination during times of emergency as well as provide improved emergency response time for physical health and safety and first response treatment. Improved communications and emergency response to citizens.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

There is no anticipation of uncompleted deliverables. Delays in payment/reimbursement as delays in tasks completed.

The Levy County Board of County Commissioners will own, maintain, and operate the EOC via the Levy County Department of Emergency Management.
