a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The goal of the appropriation is to allow Pinellas County Schools (PCS) to complete major renovations on a new professional development center space on property currently owned by the school district. The facility will provide a space for PCS teachers, leaders, and all other district employees to receive professional development training. The district will also encourage local colleges and universities to access the building through joint-use agreements.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

PCS teachers, leaders, and employees will be able to access high-quality professional development and leadership training at the center. The district will also encourage the use of the center by other educational institutions including St. Pete College and University of South Florida.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Professional development will be provided to teachers and district employees.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Over 1,000 teachers and school district employees.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The school district will track how many employees receive professional development at the center and the number of credentials earned.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Funds will be returned to the state.
