Funds used to install new anoxic digester and upgrade of existing aerated digester for stabilization of bio solids meets permitting agencies regulations and protects the environment.

Direct services to citizens, visitors, general public and businesses with the installation and operation of new anoxic digester and improved aerated digester allows for stabilization of bio-solids to Class B pathogen level at wastewater treatment plant addresses physical health of the community and protects the environment in the Peace River Basin & Charlotte Harbor Estuaries. Provides for improved water quality.

#### d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Target population in this financially disadvantaged community located in a Rural Area of Opportunity that will be served includes citizenry, residents, visitors, general public, and the business community. Population expected to be served exceeds 25,000.

Expected benefit with the installation of improvements as designed, protects the general public and the environment, Peace River Basin & Charlotte Harbor Estuaries from harm as the new equipment and upgrades will treat and stabilize bio-solids at the wastewater treatment plant maintains compliance with the permitting agencies regulations for water quality and quantity goals.
