Construction costs for improvements and replacement activities inclusive of pumping, mechanical, electrical, structural and ancillary systems.

##### c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Reduce spills to the ground and the ground water which is a threat to public health as the public water for the City of Riviera Beach Utility Special District's potable water supply wells are located in the shallow and unconfined surficial aquifer. The upgraded wastewater pump stations will reduce incidences of odor complaints from neighboring residents and the potential for failure and associated sewage overflow and sanitary hazards.
