#### 4. Project/Program Description

The purpose of the project is to give United Way of Pasco County safe and reliable housing with functional utilities to provide for victims of human trafficking statewide. Within the greater Tampa/Pasco region, often referred to as the Suncoast region, there are currently 442 trafficking intakes by the latest tally. (Florida Department of Children and Families, Office of Child Welfare, Oct 1, 2020, Annual Human Trafficking Report). This project is overseen by the United Way of Pasco County Human Trafficking Committee and will complement the United Way of Pasco County's Human Trafficking Victim Transitional Housing Program.

#### 12. Program Performance

#### a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The specific goal of this project is to provide safe, transitional housing with functional utilities for survivors of human trafficking. These funds will allow us to hire a case manager with a background in housing to manage the tenancy and utilities for victims of human trafficking who are enrolled in United Way of Pasco County's Human Trafficking Victim Transitional Housing Program, and to purchase three units of housing to provide these victims with safe, transitional housing and functional utilities for up to six months.

#### b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The funds will allow staffing of a case manager and three units of housing with functioning utilities for survivors of human trafficking in Florida.

#### c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Case Management, Housing

#### d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population for this project is survivors of human trafficking who are in need of transitional housing. This project is expected to serve twelve victims annually.



# e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected outcome of this project is do reduce the rate of recidivism for survivors falling back into the human trafficking industry. This project will provide the resources to reduce recidivism by 80% for survivors that enter the program. Our Case Manager will be calling to check up on each client every 3 months for 2 years after the client has left the program. This will allow our team to monitor the client and further ensure no relapse or recidivism from occurring.

# f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

The UWPC Human Trafficking Committee will conduct performance measures once program is finalized. Upon unsatisfactory performance, the UWPC Human Trafficking Committee will determine necessary changes required to meet expected deliverables and performance measures.

The specific units of housing that will be purchased have not yet been determined by United Way of Pasco County. The housing will be in Pasco County and will be purchased at market value.
