12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

This project will provide a safety shelter for the citizens of Marianna, Jackson County, and the surrounding area. Presently the only shelter in Jackson County is the high school. As observed after Hurricane Michael, one of the reasons students could not return to school sooner was because the school was being used as a shelter. The proposed facility can also be used as a multi-purpose building in conjunction with activities provided by the City at the MERE including sports and educational activities.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Engineering services to identify the planning and scope of the project along with drafting of the deliverable for the proposed project. The construction activities associated with the development of plans and specs of building and parking, with construction of parking area only for Phase One.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Direct services provided as a result of this project will be providing safe shelter during the time of natural disaster. Multipurpose in that the development at the MERE site where parking and facility can be used for sports activities along with educational activities.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?



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The entire population of Marianna directly, which is approximately 6,245 people. However, just as was demonstrated during and after Hurricane Michael, the facility would serve not only Jackson County but also fellow Floridians that are fleeing from other natural disasters throughout the State of Florida. It should also be noted Jackson County, along with all cities within the county have been designated by the Governor as a Rural Area of Opportunity (RAO).

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected outcome is to have a storm shelter that meets all federal, state, and local code requirements for health and safety concerns. The site within the city is over 80 miles inland and would be an asset to the State of Florida to handle evacuees.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

The contracting agency, City of Marianna, will establish a critical path with date specific targets for pre-development. Once bids are received and awarded for the project, the contract will have specific contract completion dates that, if not met, the subject the contractor to liquidated damages, assessed on a daily basis. Standard contract penalties for the contract with the state agency are sufficient.

The public will own any and all proposed facility improvements, which will be overseen by the City Commission for the City of Marianna.
