a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Funds provided by this appropriation would allow the City of Fort Walton Beach to expand its emergency services capabilities and to place a fire station in an area essential to providing services to the City's west side and Commerce and Technology Park (CTP). The CTP contains private companies that are essential to Eglin AFB and Hurlburt Field and to the U.S. military's aerospace operations. Companies such as Lockheed-Martin, Boeing, BAE, & Micro Systems are located in the CTP.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Fire Protection, emergency medical services and emergency management.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Fire Protection, emergency medical services and emergency management.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The emergency services provided by units assigned to this fire station would benefit all 21,000 residents of the City of Fort Walton Beach and others in surrounding areas of unincorporated Okaloosa County.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Improved physical health through improved Emergency Response Times; Improved quality of education through increased Fire Prevention, Life Safety & Emergency Management outreach programs to the public; Protect the general public from harm through Improved Emergency Response Times; and Increase or improve economic activity through maintained or improved ISO rating for insurance purposes.
