a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Increased amount of waste water treated and additional reclaim water flow for irrigation needs. This will allow the economy of the region to continue to expand.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Reconstruction of critical elements of the waste water plant such as the headworks, biological nutrient removal basin, clarifier structure, effluent transfer pump, yard piping and new mechanical buildings.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

An increase in the amount of wastewater that can be treated thus maintaining appropriate service and reliability to the system.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Residents of the City of Clermont and unincorporated residents of Lake County that are utility customers. In addition, the City of Clermont provides wastewater treatment for all of the Town of Oakland, parts of the town of Mount Verde, and parts of the City of Minneola.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The benefits will be an increase of the treated wastewater available for reclaim purposes. In addition, the volume of flow can be measured from its current 4MGD to the design 6.5MGD.
