a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The specific purposes are to:

1) Expand the workforce training program to add culinary training in Miami-Dade and Broward Counties through the purchase of a mobile kitchen.

2) Through the increased training program, increase the Food Home Delivery program serving homebound individuals, including seniors, by expanding Feeding South Florida's warehouse.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Enroll, train, and place training graduates in higher wage jobs. Use the training program to provide home delivered food to homebound individuals in need of assistance.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

10-week culinary training program and home delivered food for homebound individuals in need of assistance.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population is elderly persons, jobless persons, economically disadvantaged persons, and current or formerly incarcerated persons. 25-50 individuals are expected to be served.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?



Placing people with jobs, moving them from dependency to self-sufficiency. Number of people trained, graduated, and jobs placed.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Feeding South Florida will provide program services to a minimum number of Florida residents. Failure to meet the minimum number of trained residents will result in reduction of a percentage of funds relative to the percent of target met.
