Neither the PCSO nor any law enforcement agency in Pinellas County has a police pursuit driver training facility with a pursuit driving course. The development of a police driver training facility will ensure law enforcement officers develop and maintain the skills necessary to effectively and safely operate emergency vehicles, especially in high-risk situations. The project will include a basic skills training course and an advanced pursuit course, along with classroom and other training space.

More effective public safety by ensuring that law enforcement officers receive proper driver training, especially in highrisk situations.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Training law enforcement officers how to safely operate police vehicles, and maintain those skills, especially in vehicle pursuit situations.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Citizens will also have access to the course during public education programs including the Sheriff's Citizens Academy, Teen Driver Challenge, and Targeted Response Against Distracted Driving.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Primarily the PCSO's 850 law enforcement deputies will use the course but it will be shared with hundreds of other Pinellas County law enforcement officers as availability permits.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Safer police vehicle operations by deputies and police officers. A goal of effective training is to reduce deputy-involved crashes and the effectiveness of the training will be measured by whether that occurs.

Daily financial penalties for not meeting contractual deadlines.
