12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The funds will provide a location for a re-entry program for inmates seeking to remedy their substance addictions prior to re-entry into society.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Both design/engineering and construction services will be contracted with these funds to provide the facility intended with these funds.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Release inmates who have resolved their substance addictions will be contributing members of the community when reentering society.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

This project targets inmates afflicted with substance dependency who wish to resolve that condition prior to release from confinement. While the number of individuals will vary based on the condition and desire of the inmate population, it could benefit as many as 125 per month.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected benefit for this project is to house a re-entry program for inmates wanting to treat their substance addiction. The methodology measuring this outcome will be self-reporting marked by the opening of the facility ensuing the refurbishing of a building funded with these monies.

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There will be no additional penalties suggested in addition to the standard penalties provided for in our procurement policy.
