This project is to retrofit an existing property into a transitional housing facility for homeless veterans. Halifax Urban Ministries (HUM) has received a grant from the Veterans Administration for the project. HUM seeks to partner with the State to have the total necessary funding and match requirement to complete the project. At the existing Barracks of Hope, homeless veterans must share restroom facilities. This project will afford each veteran a private room with ensuite bath. This minimizes the opportunity for the spread of COVID among the facility. The VA grant was awarded to offer homeless veterans a more safe and secure living environment.
