a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The Italian Club building, a registered historic landmark, and the oldest Italian organization of its type in the United States (ref: Tony Pizzo), organized April 4th, 1894, is in need of further preservation work in order to maintain its mission within the community. One of the major aspects of this request is to bring the building up to current code, but the club is also looking into the future as it pertains to modernization and energy efficiency of the facility.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Continued success within the community as it pertains to membership, cultural enrichment activities and events, as well as community outreach programs and support of other non-profit organizations.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The Italian Club of Tampa is a historical landmark open daily for tours, as well as open for community and cultural events. The club regularly host language classes, cooking classes, culturally specific events, historical presentations, etc. It works closely with local 501c3's who utilize the club to host events that better the community through their own endeavors.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

There is no specific target. The facility is open to all of the community. The club regularly welcomes over a thousand guests each month between events, activities, tours, etc.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?



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The physical structure will be brought to code compliance and safety standards, continued success within the community as it pertains to membership; cultural enrichment activities, and events; and as community outreach programs and support of other non-profit organizations.
