The money was used for a combination of expenses such as mortgage foreclosure and rental eviction programs, emergency order compliance enforcement, PPE expenses, cleaning/disinfection, public information, public safety payroll, facilitate compliance, residential assistance, small business assistance, and community programming. The town is also anticipated to receive \$17 million from America Rescue Plan Act.

12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The Town of Davie is committed to efforts to improve the Davie Multiuse Arena facility in order to attract larger circuit rodeos, concerts, and continue to offer diverse festival programming. The requested funding will allow the town to continue its enhancement efforts in creating a venue that will become a catalyst to the revitalization of downtown Davie. This project will improve the bleachers (eastside) – renovate 4 sections to make them ADA compliant, renovate the concession buildings (northside); renovate the performance staff pavilion and bathrooms; and add office space.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The Davie Multiuse Arena has a rich history in the town. The facility is located within walking distance of the South Florida Education Center and numerous developments taking place within downtown Davie and the CRA. Some of the projects that have opened just steps away from the rodeo arena are University Pointe - 850 bed student housing project with 31,000 sq. ft. of commercial space; Zona Village - a 200 unit development with 20,000 sq. ft. of commercial space; and Main Street Lofts - a mixed use residential (42 condos) and 4,300 sq. ft. commercial space. Others to come include Mainstreet Court, Mainstreet Place, and Frontier Square. With the complete rebranding of Davie, the town anticipates a greater amount of residents and visitors will be using the facility. The town is proactively making this investment in the facility to accommodate the need. The proposed renovations will enhance the facility for greater use.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?



The Davie Multiuse Arena is a landmark and an iconic facility in the Town of Davie. This multiuse facility hosts various event types such as sports competitions, rodeo events, trade-shows, festivals, arts and crafts fairs, weddings, corporate events, conventions, and family reunions, among others. With the proposed improvements, not only will it provide ADA accessibility but it will make the facility more marketable in-terms of additional capabilities it offers to the community.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The Town of Davie is home to over 105,000 residents. Over 120,000 people across South Florida visit the arena annually for the numerous professional and amateur rodeos, festivals, concerts, and other annual and/or quarterly events hosted at the arena. Please see some statistics below on events for 2017, 2018, and 2019. Unfortunately, due to COVID-19, throughout 2020, the events planned at the facility were canceled.
