### 12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The primary goal of this funding request is that after the drought of early 2017 there was a specific need that had to be addressed concerning the irrigation water that was being drawn out of the Cape Coral canals. The drought brought the levels of these canals dangerously low and a public safety concern was initiated, since numerous fire hydrants in the city are presently on the irrigation system. The secondary goal for this funding request is to alleviate any potential flooding that may occur after a hurricane or other natural disaster strike.

### b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The City of Cape Coral has recognized a potential need to store surface water for use in the City's irrigation system beyond its two traditional supply sources (fresh water canals and reclaimed water). This effort will capture surface water, in large reservoirs, that otherwise would be released into the Gulf of Mexico. This project's expected benefit is twofold with the first being to work towards a constructive partnership with Lee County, SFWMD, FDEP and various other agencies and the second to work towards secondary uses of the reservoir for water activities and other land activities. Also another possible achievement could be realized in the form of flooding control due to hurricanes or other natural disaster strikes.

### c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Protection of the general public from harm, improve stormwater management, enhance/preserve/improve the environment

### d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

City of Cape Coral residents, upper Lee County residents and lower Charlotte County residents. 200,000 to 350,000 individuals to be served.
