### 12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

In recent years, the Santa Rosa County Economic Development office has been unable to place a number of opportunities due to the lack of wastewater capacity. The economic impact of this project will create a number of both direct and indirect jobs in the region. The environmental benefits will be derived from the elimination of surface water discharge from the existing plant.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

A number of re-use pipelines are part of the infrastructural improvements included under this application. The availability of re-use water is considered an advantage for low-cost process water for manufacturing operations.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The new plant will allow for continued growth of the area, along with improving drinking water and reducing wastewater effluent discharge into the Blackwater River. This will serve to reduce/eliminate nutrient loadings and the associated biological oxygen demand in the Bay system.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The entire population of the service area will benefit along with the economic benefits to those employed as well as environmental benefits to both residents and visitors alike.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?



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This public infrastructure construction project provides essential wastewater capacity for development of three Santa Rosa County commerce parks and is projected to create a total of 4,016 total new jobs over the first 10 years following construction. We will use job growth data from the Santa Rosa County Economic Development and the University of West Florida using regional economic modeling to measure job creation in the primary industries.
