a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Research relating to production, disease prevention, forage development, and genetic research and technology improvements.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The CEB is a 15 member board, made up of 12 producers, two IFAS faculty members, and the State Veterinarian, all appointed by the UF President The board advertises for research proposals, then holds public meeting(s) to rank the proposals and fund them depending on research priorities and monies available.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Florida is the 12th largest cattle state in the nation, and of the 25 largest cow-calf ranches in the United States. Florida has 15 of them including the largest. Nearly 1/2 of all Florida's agricultural land is in cattle production, with over 15,000 producers involved in all facets of the industry.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?



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We expect research that will serve to increase production, disease prevention, forage development, and genetic research and technology improvements. Peer review is the typical standard used, many of the projects will have "on the ground" measures, Annual audits of the CEB are conducted.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Unmet deliverables are not funded.
