a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The devastation of Hurricane Michael created a wildfire threat for years to come. Over three million acres of trees were decimated in the counties impacted by the storm. Debris, branches, tree tops, and other vegetative debris pose increased fire threats to our county, not only in rural areas but in the urban-wildland interface. Wildfires that were once quickly contained now are threats to life and property. These funds will provide critical equipment needed to mitigate the wildland threat.

With the billions of downed trees and other vegetative debris posing a wildfire threat, it is imperative that Bay County Fire Rescue has the equipment to address this threat. Not only will this benefit rural residents but those forested urban areas.

Willdland and urban fire suppression.

Full-time population of 175,000 and an annual tourist population of over 16 million. This will also be a regional asset for Hurricane Michael affected counties: Bay, Washington, Holmes, and Jackson Counties.

Preservation of life and property by way of increasing response vehicle availability and uptime. Providing essential mechanical support will decrease response times and increase total annual in service time of apparatus committed to public safety/community response.
