a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The purpose for the requested funds is to install city utility infrastructure to the new Calhoun Liberty Hospital location in order to provide the new facility electric, water, sewer, and natural gas service.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The project consists of installing approximately 3,500 ft. of 12 inch waterline, water hot taps, sewer hot taps, multiple bidirectional bores, installation of a natural gas regulator station, natural gas hot tap, approximately 3,000 ft. of underground primary wiring and 1500 kVA 3 Phase Pad Mount Transformer.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

By providing the new hospital city utilities, the entire community can receive treatment and care in a modern, state of the art hospital in the small rural community.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population is the City of Blountstown, Calhoun County, and Liberty County. Serving a combined population of 22,850 at a minimum.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected benefit is to provide utility services that meet stringent industry and state standards, while also providing the reliable utility services that are needed for the hospital to operate efficiently.
