a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The funds requested will assist with funding the improvements to the county's stormwater system to eliminate structural flooding of homes, as well as reduce roadway flooding.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Construction and construction engineering and inspection services.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The appropriation will mitigate current flooding events, which prevent ingress/egress into the area due to uncontrolled stormwater entering the area with half of homes experiencing interior flooding in heavy rain events.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

This appropriation serves to provide flooding relief and prevent repetitive loss to the Overbrook area of roughly 136 single family homes and provide secondary stormwater support to over 1,000 homes.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected benefit of the project is eliminating structural flooding and reducing roadway flooding. The way this benefit will be measured is by post-construction As-Built surveys, quality of life, and monitoring after extreme flooding events.
