### 4. Project/Program Description

The Ben Franklin Project, created and run by the Step Up America Foundation, is a supplemental resource to help teach K-5 (or higher) students civics, government and American history aligned to Florida standards. The focus is the country's founding principles, Constitution, Bill of Rights, culture, values, structure of government and the importance of becoming responsible, engaged citizens. The Project uses virtual avatars depicting significant historical figures such as Benjamin Franklin, Thomas Jefferson and Frederick Douglas who interact real time with students in the classroom to impart what was most important in a particular period of American history and how events unfolded and shaped the nation we have today. It is a unique supplemental teaching aide that keeps the attention of children in a way they will remember. Over the past 3 years at the invitation of teachers the Project has made classroom presentations in 11 Florida counties.

### 12. Program Performance

### a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Elementary school students across Florida will learn civics, government and American history aligned with Florida civics and government standards. The Project will be scaled with the recruitment, hiring and training of additional actors to voice avatars; avatars depicting several more historical figures will be developed; lesson plans and scripts/curriculum will be developed for each avatar; and lesson plans and curriculum to meet the 2023-24 revised Florida civics standards will be developed to present in as many classrooms as possible in Florida's 1892 elementary schools that school year.

### b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Step Up America Foundation will hire and train the personnel necessary; develop additional historical figures as avatars; recruit, hire and train all avatar voice actors; do outreach to all Florida elementary schools, teachers, school Superintendents and school districts; and work with the Florida Department of Education to develop integrated curriculum for several disciplines; and be responsible for all presentations.

### c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

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All Florida citizens will benefit by having more elementary school students knowledgeable about civics, government and American history and better prepared for the classes they will have in these subjects in later grades and college as well as having the foundational tools to be good and responsible citizens as adults.

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d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The roughly 1.5 million K-5 students in Florida schools

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Elementary school students across the state will learn civics, government and American history to a degree never before seen in Florida schools. They will be better prepared for middle and high school when it comes to social studies, and they will be much better prepared to be citizens as adults. Outcomes will be measured by simple tests prepared by Step Up America Foundation that teachers will be asked to administer before and after each avatar presentation. The results will be compiled and used as reference points for success and for improvements to curriculum and presentations.
