Tourism will increase due to the convenience of a centrally located parking facility within the historic downtown Sanford area. The location makes this easy for visitors not as familiar with the area when perusing downtown Sanford. Create specific immediate opportunities and once constructed, may bring parking garage-related job opportunities. Also, there will be a retail liner component which will bring job opportunities to the retail portion of the project. Contracting and procurement purposes.
