a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Construction of the infrastructure for a 25+/- acre business-aviation-industrial park which includes internal circulation roads, all onsite utilities, telecommunication/fiber, and all required stormwater attenuation. Pad ready building site(s) in the park has the potential to create up to 200 new permanent jobs and capital investment in aviation.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Construction of Infrastructure for a 25+/- acre business-aviation-industrial park.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Pad ready building site(s) in the business park will accommodate existing and new tenant business expansion initiatives, both aviation and nonaviation, that create job opportunities for local citizens. This is in addition to the construction jobs.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

General. 401-800 people.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Improve transportation conditions. Improve roadway to the business park and airport and link airport activities/functions. Increase aviation operations (landings/departures). Increase or improve economic activity. Attract new jobs and increased capital investment in Seminole County. Attract new companies and jobs to the airport that will increase the levels of productivity. Create specific immediate job opportunities. Provide approximately 200 to 400 new permanent jobs. Enhance specific individuals economic self sufficiency. Approximately 200 to 400 new permanent jobs. Track the wage and benefit increase from previous jobs and new hires entering the work force. Improve wastewater management. Include gravity and force main waste water facilities. The number of customers connected to water and waste water systems, both pre and post construction of the project. Improve stormwater management through stormwater quality treatment up to standards. Analyze the stormwater pollutants.
