a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Funds requested to establish the Hamilton Center at the University of Florida as a center of teaching and research, staffed with externally recruited, Center-based faculty to be appointed at regular rank. The center will create degree programs and offer courses in fulfillment of general education requirements for students across the university.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The Hamilton Center at UF will provide university courses, recruit distinguished faculty, and support outreach and research efforts focused on the foundations of the American republic and the western intellectual tradition.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The direct services to citizens will include civic education programming, teacher training, public-facing lectures and events, and a center of learning and inquiry for the entire community.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

When fully operational, the Hamilton Center will provide opportunities for approximately 2,500-5,000 UF students; and opportunities to enhance the civic education of 20,000-50,000 Florida high school students.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The Board of Trustees and President of the University of Florida will appoint the Hamilton Center Board of Fellows, an external academic advisory board to assist in the recruitment of distinguished faculty to the Center. Methods for measurement: Monitoring/measuring development of undergraduate and graduate curricular and co-curricular offerings, graduation & job placement/salaries, and expanded research/outreach/collaboration accomplishments.
