12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The main goal of this project is the widening of this corridor to improve drainage and to accommodate pedestrian, bicycle, and vehicular activity to address safety and flooding issues along the road by improving the roadway and drainage of an area in the Town of Medley.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Contracted activity and services under this funding include surveying, demolition, clearing, geotechnical services, design, permitting, cost estimating and construction of drainage and landscape improvements.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

This is a much-needed mobility, landscape and drainage improvement project as documented in several local meetings with support by residents and elected officials and at the Mobility Report. The main services of this project include protecting the general public and providing safety and security to local residents by enhancing pedestrian access and sidewalks and by providing drainage. This project will also improve accessibility, security, and crime protection by enhancing landscape lighting.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population of this project is local residents, as well as other pedestrian and bicyclists from the city and neighboring areas and visitors that will benefit with the recreational and safety features of the project.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected benefits of this project are safety to pedestrians and bicyclists, drainage improvements as well as community awareness through a public education program. The methodology for this project includes structural as well as non-structural components to provide a comprehensive approach. Stormwater management combined with landscape improvements and public education will be the hallmark of this project success.
