a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Restoration of natural river shoreline.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Preservation of natural park trail system along shoreline and restoration of natural shoreline to allow normal erosion patterns as opposed to unnatural patterns due to disaster events.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Direct services is difficult to measure, is more of an indirect benefit to natural ecology restoration.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

General public as a natural project. No direct target population.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Enhance/preserve/improve environmental or fish and wildlife quality. Natural Bank Restoration, reversal of unnatural river bank erosion, resulting in loss of approximately 70 feet of shoreline and natural park area. Protection of highly used natural park along the river bend. The rapid erosion is threatening the usefulness of the park trail system. Restoration to its natural shoreline condition and annual riverbank erosion measurements to record effectiveness of mitigation.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?



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The proposed appropriation should be awarded on a reimbursable basis. Failure to adhere to deliverables or performance measures would would not be eligible for reimbursement.
